Haunted Houses - Part 1

This month I am going to explore how to detect the irregular energies of haunted houses from a Feng Shui perspective. Next month, I will provide some Feng Shui solutions to help alleviate these very dark “yin” energies.

It is the perfect time to explore paranormal activity, as we are only a couple of weeks away from August, which is known as the month of “Hungry Ghosts.” This is the lowest point of the year, because the gates of the lower realms are opened and hungry ghosts and other spirits wander the Earth looking for food to eat on all levels.

When dealing with a house that appears to be haunted, there are a few “tools” one can use to help in the assessment. The needle of an ordinary compass is one very good indicator that there may be paranormal activity in or around a building. When trying to measure the direction the house faces, the compass needle may become very disturbed and randomly dart back and forth or it may just keep spinning around and around. If you feel there are ghosts or spirits in your home, try taking a compass reading. You may be very surprised at what you discover.



The Chinese compass (Lo Pan) pictured to the left is another tool. It has an unique, extremely sensitive compass needle that not only turns around to measure magnetic directions, but also moves up and down to indicate vibrational disturbances.

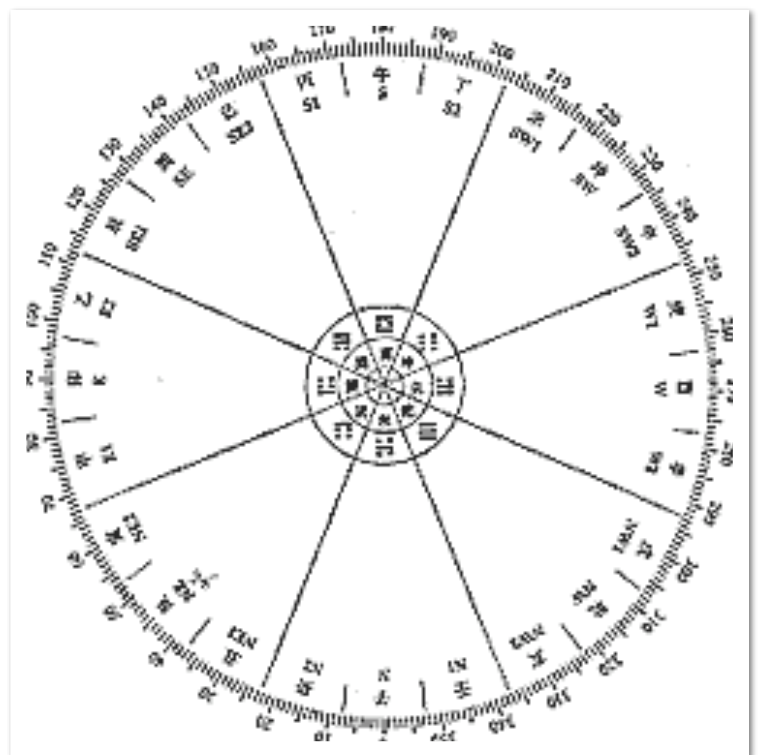
One more instrument used to measure the presence of spirits is a special Trifield Meter (sometimes called a ghost meter) which is available at my website store (link at the end.) It detects magnetic anomalies and can be set up in your home to measure paranormal activity. Some ghost

hunters set it up in a cemetery at night and then watch for movement of the dials. When there is activity, they take several photographs. Some of the pictures they capture of ghostly images are amazing.

When the above movements of the Compass Needle or Trifield Meter are witnessed in a home, the house may be truly haunted or else built over an area of geomantic stress (disturbance of the earth's natural magnetic field by either natural or man-made phenomena.) In a future news letter, I will explore geopathic stress, but for now we are looking at the phenomena of recording the presence of ghosts or spirits. The haunted house may be built on top of burial grounds, a battlefield, or the house itself may have been the site of murder, suicide or other acts of violence. Then again, there may just be a former occupant of the home who is not ready to move on. The temperature of a haunted houses is usually very cold.

I had one such consultation with a family who had just moved from their home. The clients had moved out of their dream home and into another house because of the bewildering experiences they endured for six months. Their children were afraid to go down the hall to their bedroom because they always saw a wolf at the end of the hallway. The older daughter regularly saw an older man standing at the foot of her bed at night. There were numerous other unnerving experiences. Then, one morning, the mother went into the kitchen to make breakfast and saw blood splattered all over the place with no carcasses in sight. She frantically cleaned up the blood so the children would not be alarmed. The children sat down to eat breakfast at the breakfast bar and one of them, looking under the bar, saw blood and screamed. The mother had forgotten to clean up under the bar, and so she told them what had happened. They moved out that day! I went to investigate the house for them and could not get a compass reading. The needle just kept spinning around. The temperature of the house was ice cold and I had goose bumps just walking through it. The house was on the market for a very long time, because potential buyers found it cold and uncomfortable. Finally, it sold way below market value. It was built on Indian burial grounds.

Another way to measure for paranormal conditions is to take a compass reading from the front of the house. If the magnetic degree falls directly on one of the eight major compass divisions (see diagram to the right,) there usually is magnetic disturbance. Each of the eight divisions is a different energy (yin or yang water, wood, fire, earth or metal.) If the compass reading is exactly on a dividing line, the energy is mixed and not pure. Structures with such alignments have irregular magnetic fields. The energies in the house seem to be confused, unstable and stuck. The inhabitants many times register this unsettled energy as ghosts or spirits and feel their



house is “haunted.”

I had a good chance to experience the above situation a few years ago. I was invited by a friend to go out to the Sunland/Tujunga area with a paranormal investigator from UCLA’s Paranormal Lab. He took us to five different houses that had been certified by UCLA with paranormal activity. At four of the houses, the compass degree of the facing of the house was exactly on one of the eight major divisions.

The Feng Shui system, “Flying Stars,” is another way to measure paranormal activity. It creates an energetic blueprint of a building’s energies based on the magnetic direction the structure faces and the year it was built. Certain energetic combinations indicate whether a home, or specific area of a home, may be haunted. I have experienced several situations where this “Flying Star” information has been verified.

In one instance, a client was trying to decide whether to rent a very expensive apartment. The Flying Stars information indicated that the very heart (center) of the place was ruled by ghosts or spirits. While we were walking through of the apartment, I told her the Flying Stars indicated that the place was haunted. At that very moment, the client, her friend and I became ice cold. The pen she was holding to take notes, suddenly flew out of her hand and smashed into the wall. Needless to say, she did not rent the apartment!
